March 14: Track that Scat

Even if we cannot see animals, that doesn't mean that they aren't there. We will learn about ways to identify animals without seeing them!

April 11: Nocturnal Animals

Did you know that when you go to bed, there are many animals that are just waking up! We will learn about the amazing traits that help these animals live in the dark!

May 9: Gardening

It's time to start your gardens! We are going to read about Little Groundhog and how he grows his garden!

June 13: Nature's Shapes

We are going to read about shapes found in nature and then go out and find our own!

July 11: Life in the Marsh

There are so many creatures found in the marsh and we are going to read about turtles and see if we can see some!

August 8: Camouflage

Many animals use camouflage to hide from predators or to catch their prey. We are going to read about different animals that use camouflage and then see if we can find any camouflaged animals outside!

September 12: Caterpillars
