K-5th Grade

*These programs compliment the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS)*

**Bird Migration:** Learn why ducks, geese, and other birds migrate and what obstacles they may encounter on their incredible journey.

**Nature Detectives:** Students will learn how to spot animal signs in nature and use the clues that an animal leaves behind to determine what animal was in the area.

**Terrific Turtles :** Students will listen to a story and then learn about the habitats, adaptations, and food preferences of Midwest turtles. Includes live turtles.

**Animal Adaptations:** Students will learn about animal adaptations and how different species survive in various environments.

**Owl Pellets:** These birds of prey have a unique way of digesting their food. Learn how an owl turns its food into a pellet and how you can use this pellet to find out what they have been eating. \*\*Supplies would be delivered to the school before the program.

**Live Snakes:** Are all snakes venomous? What do they eat? How big do they get? We'll answer these questions and more while students virtually visit the live snakes that live with us at Nahant Marsh .
