







Getting to Nahant Marsh



From Davenport, Iowa—take Highway 22 south, turn left on Wapello Avenue (last turn before I-280 overpass) and follow road signs.

From Rock Island, Illinois—take I-280 to lowa to the Highway 22/Rockingham Road exit. Turn right onto Highway 22 and right onto Wapello Avenue.

Follow Wapello toward the river, Nahant Marsh will be on the left just before the railroad crossing.
